CLLIMATE CRISIS

Indigenous Peoples, <u>especially</u> <u>nomadic and semi-nomadic</u> <u>communities</u>, must be recognized as key actors in climate and biodiversity governance, with full respect for their rights to land, territories, and resources.





COMBAT VIOLENCE & DISCRIMINATION

Indigenous Peoples continue to face systemic violence, racism, and discrimination - especially women, youth, and persons with disabilities - requiring urgent action to uphold human rights and dignity.

DATA SOVEREIGNTY

Indigenous Peoples are calling for control over how data about them is collected, stored, and used— ensuring it aligns with their values, protects their knowledge, and supports self-determination.







YOUTH & INTERGENERATIONAL KNOWLEDGE

There is a continuing need to empower Indigenous youth and ensure the transmission of traditional knowledge, languages, and cultural practices across generations to sustain identity and resilience.

KEY DECISIONS AND FUTURE WORK

- <u>Enhanced participation</u> of Indigenous Peoples and encourage UN entities and partners to fund preparatory meetings.
- Urge the UN Secretary-General to appoint a special envoy or adviser, in consultation with Indigenous Peoples, to promote their rights and follow up on the 2014 <u>World Conference</u> outcome document.
- Requests Member States to ensure Indigenous Peoples' meaningful participation in preparatory processes for the UN Water Conferences of 2026 and 2028.
- Requests Member States to contribute to the Trust Fund on Indigenous Issues managed by <u>DESA</u>.
- Recommends UN entities ensure Indigenous Peoples' inclusion in AI and digital technology governance processes; offers assistance in identifying experts.
