UNITED NATIONS STATISTICAL COMMISSION

2030 CENSUS PROGRAMME

Adopted a resolution urging Member States to conduct at least one census between 2025 and 2034, reinforcing data comparability, integrity, and timely dissemination.





2025 SYSTEM OF NATIONAL ACCOUNTS

Adopted a resolution endorsing the implementation of the System of National Accounts 2025 as the international standard for national accounts statistics.

DATA GOVERNANCE

Created a Working Group on Data Governance to cooperate closely with a related working group under the Commission on Science and Technology for Development, supporting follow-up activities to the Global Digital Compact.





WELL-BEING MEASUREMENT

Established an Expert Group on Well-being Measurement to lay the technical groundwork for the forthcoming GDP and Beyond debate at the political level.

SDG INDICATOR MONITORING

Adopted the outcomes of the 2025 comprehensive review of the SDG indicator framework, commending the inclusive and transparent process and encouraging continued efforts to address data gaps and strengthen methodological consistency for global SDG monitoring.





WORLD STATISTICS DAY

Welcomed the report of the Secretary-General on World Statistics Day and endorsed the theme "Driving change with quality statistics and data for everyone," encouraging continued preparations and outreach for the 2025 celebration at national, regional, and global levels.
